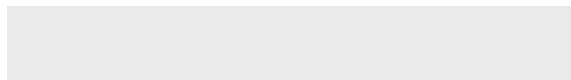

Purpose

The main purpose of the Miss Louisiana Leatherette Contest is to serve as a seasonal fund-raiser for the Mystic Krewe of the Lords of Leather. Its goal is to promote the leather community in a positive image among the larger gay community of Louisiana. The contest is a “tongue in cheek” look at the world of Leather contests held annually around the world.

Judging:

There are four categories for contestant judging.

Parish Costume – a creative interpretation of costuming representing a designated Parish (county) of the state of Louisiana. The Parish represented will be of the contestant’s own choosing. (Maximum score 25 points)

Talent – A three-minute stage talent presentation of the contestant’s choosing. All contestants are responsible for their own CD formatted music (no tapes) or musical accompaniment if needed. (Maximum score 25 points)

Swim wear – Presentation of Swim wear of the contestants choosing. (Maximum score 25 points)

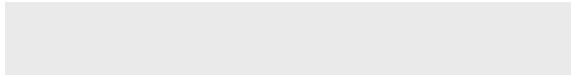
Evening Gown/Fetish – Presentation of evening wear suitable for the final awards ceremony. (Maximum score 25 points)
